Pursuant to SB 404, Section 5.5 & Section 7

The information in this form must be filed annually with the local district for any homeschooled child requesting participation in programs of special education, or any classes or activities, or sports or interscholastic activities and events, at a public or charter school. The parent may be required to provide additional information specific to the participation request. Consult the law and regulations pertaining to the program or activity being requested to determine your parental rights, the district's rights, and eligibility clauses or limitations. 6. A school district may, before providing programs of special education to a homeschooled child or authorizing a homeschool child to participate in classes or extracurricular activities, require proof of identity of the child, including, without limitation, the birth certificate of the child or other documentation sufficient to establish the identity of the child.

A school district shall, before allowing a homeschooled child to participate in any interscholastic activities and events, including those governed by the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association, require proof of identity of the child, including, without limitation, the birth certificate of the child or other documentation sufficient to establish the identity of the child.

SB 404

Sec. 5.5.

1. The Department shall develop a standard form for the notice of intent of a homeschooled child to participate in programs and activities. The board of trustees of each school district shall, in a timely manner, make only the form developed by the Department available to parents of homeschooled children.

2. The notice developed pursuant to subsection 1 must include the information required in the notice of intent to homeschool pursuant to section 5 of this act, excluding the educational plan for the homeschooled child.

3. If a homeschooled child wishes to participate in classes, activities, programs, sports or interscholastic activities and events at a public school or through a school district, or through the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association, the parent of the child must file a current notice of intent to participate with the school district in which the child resides.

This form complies with the requirements of SB 404 Section 5.5, subsection 1.
