Educational Plan - INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS:

Curriculum Guides:

List all materials you use in developing the child's educational plan for one school year (the year you submit the NOI). List the author, title, publisher, city, state and year published.

Example Format:

Darling, Wendy, ***How to Teach Your Child***, (Never-Never Land, England: Pan Press, 1911).
Toto, Frank L., ***Homeschooling: The Only Choice***, (Rainbow, KS: WoO Pub., 1865)

English

Reading:

List reading books (readers), phonics programs, testing materials (such as comprehension) and independent age-appropriate reading materials, etc. according to the format above. Remember even if you list them it doesn't mean you have to use them all or finish them all.

Composition and Writing:

List spelling programs/workbooks, Language Arts programs, writing programs, handwriting programs, Grammar, etc. according to publication format.

Mathematics:

List math textbooks, programs, games, manipulatives, etc. at the appropriate level for your child.

History/Geography:

List history/geography materials by publication name/format (books, textbooks, maps, magazines, timelines, atlas, software, etc) you plan to use (if appropriate for your child's age and ability). For instance I might choose not to teach history or geography in second grade so I would not list anything here if submitting paperwork for this grade level. You are not required to teach every subject every year taught every.

Science/Health:

List science materials (books, textbooks, lab equipment, field trips, software programs, The list could go on and on).

Other textbooks, equipment, and information sources as appropriate in the study of Music, Art, Physical Education, Home Economics and Character Development as appropriate for the child's skill level may be used.

Other Resources include but are not limited to: Public Library; globes and maps; encyclopedias; museums; local, state and national parks; planetarium; rivers and lakes; magazines, newspapers, and computer software and the internet as appropriate for the child's age and skill level.
